**Directions:**

Cards –

- There are 30 playing cards. The teacher may laminate these cards for reuse.

Hop and Write Directions –

- Hop and Write is a game that gets students moving around the classroom while practicing grammar skills. Students will need a clipboard with their “Hop and Write” recording page and a pencil. To begin, each student will receive a card to place on his/her desk. At the beginning of the game, students will begin with the card on their own desk, writing the answer on their “Hop and Write” recording page by the matching number. After 30 seconds (teacher may vary this time, as needed) the teacher will say “Hop and Write” (or give a signal of some sort). At this signal, students will move to the seat to their right, read the card at that desk and record the answer by the matching number on the recording page. Students will continue hopping and writing until they have rotated all the way back to their own seats.
- Once back at their own seats, the teacher will ask the students to put away pencils and take out a crayon. Students will check their own work with the crayon while the teacher guides them through finding the answers. Optional: The teacher may collect recording pages to grade as an assessment.

NOTE: If you have fewer than 30 students, you may want to have your students cross out the extra boxes before the game. If this is the case, the teacher will want to discard the cards with those matching numbers.
