Collecting Collective Nouns Game

Players: 2-4

Object: to collect 3 collective noun matches

Set Up: Place all “collective noun” cards in a bag. Place all “noun” cards in a bag. Each player should draw three noun cards from the sack and three collective noun cards. Players should lay noun cards face up. The goal is to find the collective nouns to match these three cards. If a player has matches, he/she may lay those down now. Lay all remaining collective noun cards upside down in rows.

The person whose birthday comes first in the year goes first.

How to Play: Player 1 selects a collective noun card from the rows. If it is a match, he/she may play it. If not, he/she must lay one card down in its place (the card just drawn cannot be placed back down on this turn).

Play continues to the right. The first person to match all 3 cards is the winner!

This game may be played several times by selecting new noun cards from the bag.
