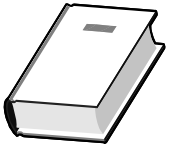




DICTIONARY ENTRIES



A dictionary entry has many different parts. Some of the parts you will find are the word, its part of speech, its definition, and a meaningful sentence with the word. Look at the example below.

cat	<i>noun</i>	a meat-eating mammal that can be kept as a pet and can be used for catching mice;
